

. Barbara L will make a club membership form to be filled out by all members, it will be in the first Newsletter. Pam also mentioned that we need to merge to one Roster, Andy offered to reach out.

ODA and CRDA websites are done by Melinda, they will be merged into one.

- . The suggestion was made that we have a contest for a new LOGO design, think about something fun. A date for submission has not been determined at this point.
- . Vicky suggested a committee to review and revise the BYLAWS.
- . Vicky for CRDA and Bonnie for ODA will review and revise the BYLAWS and Standing Rules, they will be changed at a later date and sent to Barbara L.
- . A motion was made by Suzy and seconded by Lynn to keep the membership fee at \$20.00.
- . Instructors should get \$10.00 per person per class plus the cost of materials needed. \$5.00 per person per class goes towards the facility rental. \$15.00 minimum plus materials as needed. If using outside Instructor's materials, we need to have written permission from said Instructors to use their materials.
- . Meeting places:

At ODA we are covered by the Art Center's Insurance, Hampton Inn's Insurance covers the CRDA meeting.

- . For now, we will keep the current meeting places until we can find something more convenient for all members and vote on it. Bonnie suggested that for now we keep the same meeting days.
- . February 18th meeting will be at ODA. February 24th and 25th will be the CRDA Zoom meeting.
- . March ODA, 3rd Saturday, Pam Caley will be instructor with a colored pencil.
- . April CRDA will meet on the fourth Saturday.
- 11.40am Lynn made a motion to close the meeting, Barbara Fowler seconded.

Supplies:

9" x 12" firm support board (smooth surface), if using paper, bulldog clip or low tack tape to secure paper to the board, pencil sharpener (handheld and/or electric), kneadable eraser, soft mop or hake brush for whisking off debris, tracing paper, fine tip permanent ink black marker, fine tip stylus, white graphite paper (used is best), paper towel or Kleenex to place under your hand to protect paper.

Pre-Class Preparation:

- Trace the line drawing onto tracing paper. Or, better yet, cut your tracing paper to 8 ½" x 11" and put it in the paper tray of you printer. Print the line drawing onto the tracing paper. **Note**: all printers are different, so be sure to measure the design area of your printed line drawing to make sure it fits nicely on your surface.
- Position the tracing onto your surface and secure with low tack tape.
- Place graphite under the tracing, making sure that the 'graphite' side of the paper is facing down.
- Use the fine tip of a stylus (or a very fine tip ball point pen) to lightly transfer the pattern onto the paper. After a few lines, lift the graphite and check to see if the lines are too dark or too light and adjust your pressure accordingly.
- Remove the graphite paper and lift the tracing up from the surface. Use the kneaded eraser to soften any lines that are too dark/heavy.


We also have several very talented artists in our group that I would love to hear from to teach a class, or grab a buddy and the two of you team up if you want to teach something together. I will help you make it happen!

We will be trying something new and doing a project from an e-book. Lydia Steeves' "The Resting Place" is a colored pencil piece using Pan Pastels on paper (zebras). Each student will go online and purchase the e-book and bring a laptop/tablet into class and work from that in class. Several people have already ordered their own e-book and I have ordered the Pan Pastels, some sponges and a few of the Neo color II white pastel to share in class and will bring odorless thinner. The surface will be your choice of what you want to bring, but lists Stonehenge Fawn 9 ¾" x 9 ¾" paper and Scharff moon scrubber \$0 and #2 brushes. The pencils are the following Prismacolor Premiere pencils: Ultramarine PC902, True Blue PC903, Non-Photo Blue PC919, White PC938, Black PC935, Burnt Ochre PC943, Sunburst YellowPC917.
