

October Program

Using stroke work to fill negative space and fine line detailing.

Surface: 3-3/4" lids for the utility glasses we bought from Ken Oakley a while back...or enlarge to fit whatever two round surface you wish to work on.

Paint: Supplied by Jean in colors compatible with your red holly berries. Two different (dull red & green) for strokework will be available.

Brushes: Good quality & in good condition with good square corned #4, #6, & #8 flat shaders and a good #1 fine liner you're used to working with for line detailing

Prep work before class: As shown in the picture you will receive two holly patterns when you sign up for the class. One is to be placed to one side nearer the edge and the other will be placed in the center of your surface. You may feel free to enlarge the two designed to fit the 3-3/4" lids...but please do not reduce.

You need to paint BOTH the designs prior to the workshop, as we will be covering stroke work and detailing **NOT PAINTING HOLLY**. Along with the two patterns, you will receive suggested colors for the leaves & berries of the holly. You may paint the designs with the suggested colors or choose to do the designs in your own personal favorites.

I will have some dry sta-wet palette paper available for practice before you go onto your finished holly painting surfaces.

There is a stroke work pattern packet available for \$5.00 that shows numerous examples of both stroke work patterning and fine line detailing. Three pages are in color and also there are patterns for practicing the strokes & details. I will bring along a packet for those requesting a packet prior to **October 1st** as I must assemble the materials and do not wish to make more copies than needed.

Colored Pencil - Beginner - Intermediate Level

Surface: 9"x12" Whitster Green hand-dyed paper available from Janelle

Supplies:

Prismacolor Colored Pencils:

- Burnt Ochre
- Canary Yellow
- Cool Grey 10, 50, 90%
- Dark Brown
- Indigo Blue
- Spanish Orange
- Terra Cotta
- Warm Grey 50%
- White
- Yellow Ochre

Scotch Transparent Tape, red label for removing color pencil from paper.

Gray graphite for transferring design to the collage paper.

Optional: Lineco Neutral pH adhesive for adhering paper to wood panel.

Sponge brush to spread the adhesive

Rubber Cutting mat for trimming paper from around wood panel

E-xacto knife, No. 11 blade to trim paper

The painting can also be adhered to a wood surface after the penciling is completed.

Krylon Workable Fixatif, No. 1306 for spraying the pencils when finished

DecoArt Traditions Satin Finish Varnish for final protective finish.

"Too Hot to Handle"

Colored Pencil

Surface: 6"x19" Chai Tea handmade paper (See notation below).

Supplies: Prismacolor Premier Colored Pencils:

Moss Green	Yellowed Orange
White	Nectar
Indigo Blue	Yellow Ochre
Goldenrod	French Grey 10%
Burnt Ochre	French Grey 50%
Espresso	

Prismacolor Verithin Pencil, Orange #737 for transferring drawing to the paper.

Scotch Removable Tape, blue label for removing color pencil from paper.

Gray graphite for transferring the drawing to the paper.

Hand-held pencil sharpener, Sandpaper pad to sand pencil core to a needle sharp point

Kneadable eraser for removing unwanted colored pencil

Optional: 6"x18" Masonite panel to mount paper

Lineco Neutral pH adhesive for adhering paper to masonite.


2" Sponge brush to spread the adhesive

The painting can also be adhered to a wood surface after the penciling is completed.

Krylon Workable Fixatif, No. 1306 for spraying the pencils when finished

DecoArt Traditions Satin Finish Varnish for final protective finish.
