Any regular colored pencil supplies that you use. Make sure to include transfer paper, erasers and sharpeners of choice.

10/0 liner brush or #1 or #2 round.

A Note From Marsha

If anyone wants to paint the daisies we did in August changing the colors to **blues** instead of **pinks**, here are the color substitutes:

Pattern Calls For:	Change To:
Baby Pink Deep	Baby Blue Deep
Fuchsia	True Blue
Wine	Navy Blue
Crimson	Primary Blue

Before painting on your piece, test the True Blue and Navy Blue on a scrap to see if the colors are too dark. I added a touch of white to the True Blue to lighten it a little. The Navy may not need the white if you are using a very light touch. Remember the Navy is the dull shading color.

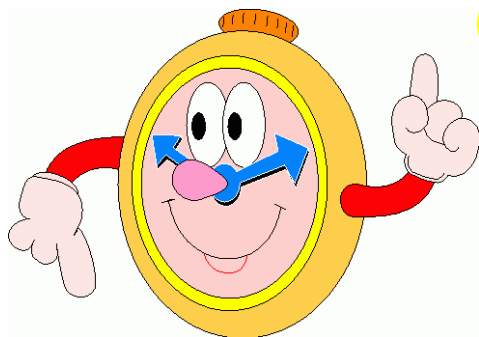
